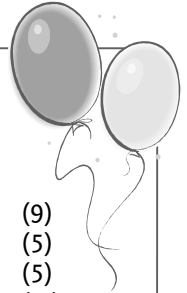

DEVAR TORAH

SHABBAT SHEKALIM

When the Temple stood, it was incumbent upon every Jew to perform the positive mitzvah of contributing half a shekel yearly for the purchase of the communal offerings that were to be offered on the altar. During a given year, only the half-shekel contributions of the same year could be used for this purpose.

Even a poor person dependent upon charity gave half a shekel. This he did even if it meant borrowing from others, pawning, or selling one of his garments, as it says, “the rich shall not increase, and the poor shall not diminish from half a shekel” (Shemot 30:10).

All the half-shekel pieces were due in the Temple by Rosh Chodesh Nisan each year. On Rosh Chodesh Adar, public announcements were made to remind everyone of this mitzvah so that each person could prepare his half-shekel and give it at the appropriate time. On the 15th Adar, collectors sat in each city and people voluntarily brought the money to them, but no coercion was applied. On the 25th of the month, the collectors sat in the Temple and henceforth, the contributions were mandatory.

Our Sages decided that on the Shabbat immediately preceding Rosh Chodesh Adar, the portion dealing with the half-shekel contribution was to be read from the Torah, since all the people would be present in Synagogue and would hear the first call for the fulfillment of the mitzvah in its proper time. Despite the fact that the Temple no longer exists, we continue till this day with the custom of reading this special Maftir. In anticipating the speedy rebuilding of the Temple, it is necessary for us to retain our familiarity with this practice. In addition, it is our prayer that the Torah Reading might be regarded as equal to the practical fulfillment of performing this mitzvah.

Mitzvot: 53 of the 613 Mitzvot; 23 positive and 30 negative
Verses: 118 (22nd longest of the 54 Sidrot)
Words: 1462 (31st longest)
Letters: 5313 (37th longest)
Haftarah: 21 verses (31st shortest of the 80 Haftarot)

The verses of Mishpatim are amongst the shortest in the Torah. Only Ki Tetze, Emor and Re'eh (in that order) have more Mitzvot than Mishpatim. 40% of the 613 Mitzvot are in these 4 Sidrot!
