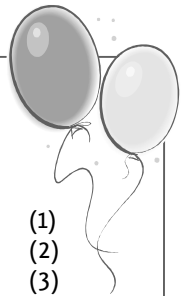

DEVAR TORAH

ZECHER LEMIKDASH

Today, we commence five Sidrot which describe the construction, furnishing and sacrificial rites of the Mishkan (Sanctuary) in the Wilderness, which was later replaced by our two Temples. Many of the details in these portions bear reference to our lives today. In particular, we adopt many procedures as *zecher lemikdash*, through which our recollections of Temple service guide and inspire us in our daily lives. The following are a few examples:

WASHING OF HANDS – In Temple times, the *Cohanim* needed to purify their hands before they ate the holy *Terumah* contribution, which amounted to 2% of the farmer's produce that was given as a gift to them. After the destruction of the Second Temple, our Sages feared that the purifying method would become lost in the course of time. They, therefore, introduced a *halachah*, whereby all Jewish people would use that special method of washing prior to the eating of bread. This is the origin of our washing procedure which we diligently continue to this day.

SALT ON BREAD – Salt is added to bread after the *Hamotzi* blessing is recited. This is to recall the way in which salt was added to all sacrifices on the altar. Our tables represent the altar and the food we eat reminds us of the offerings thereon. In this way, mealtimes are transformed into a spiritually meaningful family experience. Salt is remarkable. Sodium and chlorine by themselves would never be considered as items of food, but, when combined together, they produce salt, which is a staple part of our diet and a very important preservative. Salt, thus, reminds us of the sometimes inexplicable ways in which Hashem's greatness enables us to survive.

THE TABLE DURING BENCHING – After many sacrifices were completed, leftover parts of the animal remained on the altar. Indeed, the *Ma'ariv* service was introduced after the Destruction, in order to remember those parts of the animal left on the altar overnight. With this in mind, our tables should not be totally cleared before benching. Any bread that has not been consumed should be left on the table. In the event that all bread has been eaten, then, at the very least, some salt should be on the table while we bench.

Some families have the additional custom to remove the *challah* knife or all knives from the table prior to benching. In this way, we recall how no iron implement was used in the construction of the altar, seeing as weapons of war are fashioned from iron. The Temple was to be an ongoing symbol of universal peace. Similarly, our benching should enhance domestic peace. Indeed, the final sentiment of our Grace after Meals is a prayer for *Shalom*.
