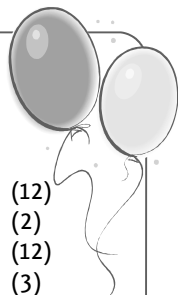




YOUTH

DEVAR TORAH

MISHLOACH MANOT

As the term “Mishloach Manot” implies, we fulfil this mitzvah by sending at least two ready-to-consume items of food to at least one person. Both food and drink are considered to be a “manna” (portion) for this purpose.

Two separate reasons are given in our traditional sources for this mitzvah. According to some, the primary reason is to increase harmony, peace and neighbourliness. The mitzvah is a lovely gesture through which feelings of closeness are expressed. Others explain that the essence of the mitzvah is to provide poor people with the necessities of a Purim Seudah. Seeing as they might not have the means to purchase food for the Purim meal, our Mishloach Manot would assist them to celebrate the Festival in an appropriate way.

Bearing in mind these two reasons, there should be two types of recipients of our Mishloach Manot. Firstly, those who could genuinely benefit from having the additional food in their homes and, secondly, those who will be touched by a warm gesture of friendship.

The mitzvah of Mishloach Manot provides us with an opportunity to soothe differences and ease tensions that may have developed over the previous year among friends, acquaintances and neighbours. We have here a simple and easy mechanism to renew ties of friendship that have been strained. By availing of this opportunity, we are contributing towards the fulfillment of the words of the Megilla, “Go and bring together all the Jews”. The mitzvah also provides us with an opportunity to show gratitude to those to whom we owe some thanks but have not yet had an opportunity to express it.

Donating money to charities in lieu of “Mishloach Manot” is a fine way of maximizing this mitzvah. However, one should note that this must be in addition to the giving of actual Mishloach Manot on the day of Purim which is the ideal way to fulfil the precept properly.

“The future of our school is the future of our children and the future of our community.”

As many of you know, Morasha Jewish Primary School first opened its doors in September 2008.

The initiative to start a school for the Finchley community began with a small group of young families who recognised that there was shortage of school places for Jewish families who live in Finchley, and that communities unable to offer a first rate Jewish and secular education for children face the real possibility of young families moving away from the area.



The dream was to establish a modern orthodox Jewish school in Finchley which was committed to Torah values, Ivrit and Israel, and to developing pupils into responsible,



committed members of the Jewish community and society at large. When Morasha first opened its doors with seven children, this dream became a reality.

Morasha has grown and developed rapidly over the last two years and currently has 34 pupils spread over two school years. A further 25 children will be starting in both September 2010 and September 2011, with places heavily oversubscribed for both intakes.

Morasha is extremely fortunate to have Rabbi Mirvis as its Honorary Principal. The dedicated team of staff, led by Hayley Gross and Chana Kanzen, together with Rabbi Mirvis, have built a formidable reputation for the school, and they have all been instrumental in Morasha's progress and achievements to date. They have brought to life the integrated curriculums of Limmudei Chol (secular studies) and Limmudei Kodesh, enhancing the relevance of these for the children.



In September 2009 Morasha had its first Ofsted inspection, and we are delighted that the school achieved either “Good” or “Outstanding” in all the areas assessed. Ofsted particularly praised the Early Years Foundation Stage and Limmudei Kodesh curriculums and also commented on the extremely positive feedback they had received from pupils’ parents.



Morasha has successfully established links with other schools: the pupils at Morasha participated in the Chanukah Fair organised at Edgware Jewish Primary School and the relationship has continued since then. Links have also been established with Moss Hall Infant and Junior Schools.



Many of our parents are also involved in the Parent School Partnership (‘PSP’) which organises social events for current and prospective Morasha pupils and their families.
