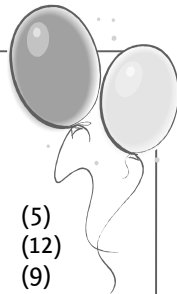

DEVAR TORAH

THOUGHTS ON THE SIRDA

“And Miriam, the Prophetess, the sister of Aaron, took a timbrel in her hand; and all the women went out after her with timbrels and with dances”

Shemot 15:20

Two questions arise from this passage which describes the way in which Miriam led the women of our people in their celebrations after the miraculous parting of the Red Sea waters. Why is Miriam described as a Prophetess? Where is there any reference to her prophesying?

One could understand Miriam being described as the daughter of Amram, the wife of Calev or the sister of Moses, but why is she described here as the sister of Aaron alone?

The Midrash describes the historical background which provides the answer to both questions. When Pharaoh issued his evil decree to destroy all sons born of Israelite parents, Amram and Yocheved decided to separate. They felt it would be irresponsible for them to bring another child into the world when there was a possibility that he could perish. Their daughter, Miriam, who was only a young girl at the time, pleaded with her parents to come together again: “While there is, indeed, a possibility for tragedy, with the help of God, we will surely be able to overcome it.” With prophetic insight, she predicted that the child who would be born would survive and be an inspiration to his people. Moved by their daughter’s words, Amram and Yocheved remarried. A year later, Moses was born and the rest, as they say, is all history.

From this Midrash, we learn how Miriam indeed had prophecy and this was at a time when only Aaron was alive but before Moses was born. Hence, the reference to her being “sister of Aaron”.

Miriam’s legacy is a powerful and eternally relevant one for us. Some of our greatest achievements are the results of calculated risks. If not for such inspired and courageous leadership, many a Synagogue, school or community centre would never have been built. We are, indeed, the disciples of Miriam.
