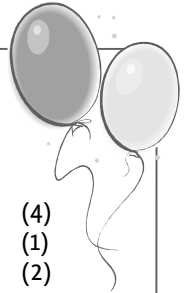

DEVAR TORAH

WHO WAS THE MAN?

“And Moshe went out to meet his father-in-law (Yitro) and he bowed down and kissed him, and the man enquired after his fellow’s welfare, and they came into the tent.” [Exodus 18:7]

It is not clear from the above text who “the man” was who initiated this encounter and enquired after the wellbeing of the other.

Rashi, citing a *mechilta*, informs us that “the man” here was Moshe and not Yitro. We know this because elsewhere in the Torah it states, *“and the man Moses was more humble than any other person upon the face of the earth”*. [Numbers 12:3].

Why could the Torah not have told us that Moshe enquired after Yitro’s welfare. Why does it instead use a convoluted method to let us know who was doing what?

Emerging from this seemingly insignificant question is a powerful message of eternal relevance. The Torah wants us to know that Moshe was a man and that in every respect he behaved like a mensch. He could easily have thought that the arrival of his father-in-law in the Israelite camp was a matter of deep embarrassment to him. After all, Yitro was none other than a Midianite priest, not exactly the yichus that the leader of the Jewish people wanted to boast about. Yet, Moshe went out of his way to do a menschedick thing. Yitro brought Moshe’s wife, Tziporah, into the world and raised her, and it was therefore appropriate in the presence of the entire people that he should behave like a gentleman and give his non-Jewish father-in-law ‘red carpet’ treatment.

“The man” was Moshe and he indeed was a mensch.

Haftarah: 21 verses (joint 31st longest of the 80 Haftarot)

Today’s Shlishi is the shortest Shlishi of the Torah. The Ten Commandments are read in Shishi. Did you know that there are 15 mitzvot in the “Ten Commandments”? The three shortest verses of the Torah are to be found in Shishi (i.e. Exodus 20:13-15).
