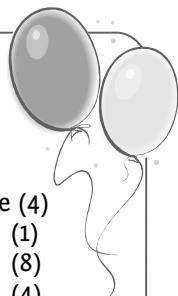

KI TISSA

“Turn from Your fierce wrath and reconsider the evil against Your people” (Exodus 32:12).

With these words, Moses pleaded with the Almighty to forgive the Israelites after they had fashioned and worshipped the Golden Calf. Moses’ prayer found its mark: “And the L-rd repented of the evil which He said He would do to His people” (32:13). This was one of two infamous sins committed in the Wilderness. The other, of course, was the sin of the spies. In the aftermath of that serious collective transgression, the entire nation begged for forgiveness: “And you spoke up and said: we have sinned against the L-rd”(Deuteronomy 1:41). Yet, amazingly, on that occasion, “The L-rd did not hearken to your voice”. The gates of repentance were firmly shut and that entire generation was condemned to die in the Wilderness.

Why did Hashem react differently to these two sins? Rabbi Menachem Mendl of Kotzk provides a very insightful explanation. The sending of the spies and the evil report that followed were rooted in a total absence of belief: “And in this matter you did not believe in the L-rd your G-d” (Deuteronomy 1:32). When the Golden Calf was worshipped, however, the people were spiritually motivated, but their quest for godliness was misdirected. As a result, there was still some hope for them as, with adequate remorse followed by appropriate instruction, they could channel their dependence upon a superior deity into the right direction. The situation, after the sin of the spies, on the other hand, was irredeemable, seeing as there was no desire to believe in and worship anything at all.

How do you tell the difference between an atheist, an agnostic and a true believer? The atheist says, “I deny”. The agnostic says, “I dunno” and the believer says, “Adonai”.

A journey from total denial to absolute belief is an improbable one. Yet, a journey from misguided dependence to true belief is certainly possible. Indeed, the worshippers of the Golden Calf proved this to be so.
